



IAQ Management and New IAQ Objectives



We spend more than 70% of our time at homes, offices, and other indoor environment. In fact, indoor environment has an essential impact on our health, comfort and productivity. Children, elderly and people with existing respiratory or heart diseases are more susceptible to the effects of indoor air pollution.

To encourage property owners/management to adopt good indoor air quality (IAQ) management practices, the IAQ Certification Scheme for Offices and Public Places has been implemented since 2003. On July 1, 2019, the IAQ objectives was updated to provide a healthier and more comfortable indoor environment in IAQ certified premises.

This seminar is organized by the IAQ Information Centre with a view to enhancing the awareness on IAQ , and providing simple and practical guidance on IAQ management. It will introduce the IAQ Certification Scheme and the new IAQ objectives, share the experience on how to maintain good IAQ.
